The Bachelor's of Technology (BT) degree is designed as a degree completion program for students with associate's degrees in applied science or equivalent. The typical student will have 18 credit hours of General Education courses and a maximum of 43 credit hours of Technical Credit courses for a total of 62 transferable credit hours. The client will need to take an additional 18 credit hours in the General Education curriculum listed below. The total number of General Education credit hours needed to graduate is 36; 18 transferred in from the community college where they received their associates and an additional 18 credit hours of General Education from the Ecollege on line.
