Applicants can schedule another observation session if all required exams are not observed. Applicants should try to schedule observation in the A.M. if possible, due to the fact that some of the fluoro exams are only performed in the A.M.

*Applicants need to have **technologists** in each area **initial** required exams after completion of exams.
