

- Go to [My.Hinds](#) and check your account status. Do you owe money, have an admissions restriction, financial aid concerns or other college business that needs to be cleared? Go to the appropriate office.
- Print your unofficial registration transcript from [My.Hinds](#). If you have attended another college check to see if the credits have been posted to your registration transcript. If not, contact the Office of Admissions and request that college transfer credits post to your record.
- Review your program of study and mark courses completed and in progress.

- Select courses that you need to take to graduate and check the pre-requisites. First-time students must see an advisor or counselor at one of the 6 campus locations. - Search for classes, dates, and times from the [online course schedule](#). Create a [trial schedule on the worksheet](#) with preference for days, times, and campus.
- Go to [My.Hinds](#) and web register for academic and/or technical classes. Career students must register in person.

- Mississippi Virtual Community College (MSVCC online) classes are not active for web registration. Select your courses based on availability from the [MSVCC schedule](#). (Choose the Course Offerings link in the menu on the left.) Classes offered by other colleges are subject to approval based on criteria set forth under the [FAQ for Hinds Distance Learning](#). Complete the [MSVCC registration form](#) and take it to the most convenient counseling office at any of the 6 campus locations.
- Check your financial aid status and the account balance at [My.Hinds](#). **The account balance is due by January 2, 2010** and may be conveniently paid online.
