WIND PLAYER CHAIR PLACEMENT

Scales: Bb, Eb, Ab, F, C, G and Chromatic (full range of the instrument)
and
Sight reading

- Everyone is required to audition for a chair.
- All flute players will play piccolo for the duration of the fall semester.
- All french horn players will audition on mellophone (trumpet fingerings).
 - You may begin checking out instruments on or after July 13th.

DORM ORIENTATION: All new dorm students (including sophomores) are required to attend orientation. Please make sure you attend orientation **BEFORE** band camp.

BAND T-SHIRTS and PONCHOS can be purchased in the bookstore.

If you have money left over from additional scholarships, tell them to charge it to your band scholarship. Each band member (including guard) is required to purchase a t-shirt and poncho.

If you already own a poncho, no need to get another.

Guard and Percussion: Please note the sectionals on Wednesdays! You should NOT schedule a class during this time

DRINK PLENTY OF WATER before and during camp. It is important to hydrate your body before spending hours in the hot sun. Fainting is a result of dehydration and heat. Take care of yourself – we want you around!

DON'T SKIP MEALS before or during band camp. Not eating increases your chances of passing out during rehearsal.

What to bring to camp:

Sunblock and sunglasses, Athletic Shoes (NO SANDALS, FLIP FLOPS or BOOTS), Small ice chest or cooler and a cup with your name on it. Water and Gatorade will be provided.

UNIFORM INFORMATION

Uniforms are provided at no additional fee, except for personal wear or cleaning. You are required to wear a maroon band t-shirt under your uniform (purchased at the bookstore). All band members are required to wear black socks. Black gloves will be provided at the first game. Each additional pair of gloves will cost \$5.

SHOE INFORMATION

WINDS and PERCUSSION are required to wear marching style shoes.

(Pinnacle #2090 or something similar - not shiny patent leather).

If you need to order shoes, a representative from Burnham Enterprises will be here to measure on August 14th at the end of band camp. The shoes will be charged to the Hinds Band but you will need to make arrangements to pay for those sometime during the fall semester (\$35).

COLORGUARD will wear split sole dance shoes (lace up).

The cost for the shoes is around \$49.

Tell them that you are a member of the Hinds CC Flag line.

Students with JOBS need to make arrangements to attend all rehearsals, pep rallies, and performances.

By-Pass and Compass test: Please make arrangements with the counseling office or other departments on campus to take this test *without* missing band rehearsal.

Jane Klinck/State Farm Scholarship – criteria – Must be enrolled in a 1 hour string orchestra class and a 1 hour string lesson class, 2.5 gpa, free of any disciplinary problems, and attend a recognition program held in the fall.

Nancy Tenhet Scholarship – criteria – must be full time freshman or soph student preferably one who plays the saxophone in the band or second preference will be given to a student who plays a woodwind instrument in the band; 3.0 gpa, free of any disciplinary problems, and must attend a recognition program.

Jesse McLendon Thrash Scholarship – criteria – Majoring in music, preference to organ or piano players, 3.0 GPA.

Carl Ashby Scholarship – criteria – Vicksburg/Warren County High School graduate, financial need, 2.5 gpa, freshman on the Raymond Campus, pursuing degree in Music.

Aaron B. Carter Scholarship– criteria – Saxophonist, music major, 2.0 gpa, financial need.
