NOTES:

- The student who has passed two years of the **same** foreign language in high school may enroll in 6 hours of intermediate foreign language. Those having only one year of language or NO language in high school must enroll in beginning foreign language. The language courses must be in the same language. If Spanish is the chosen language, Spanish I should usually be started in the fall semester of the freshman year in order to complete the two-year requirement. At the current time, Hinds teaches only one year of French; thus, French I should be started in the fall of the sophomore year with the additional year being completed at Delta State. Consult with the advisor before choosing the elective courses, and be sure that the electives are being chosen from a current Delta State University catalog.
