The Delta State University/Hinds Community College Partnership (DHP) for Elementary Education Program

Delta State University will receive applications for the Fall 2010 semester. The application process has two parts:

- (1) Complete the admissions information sheet at the end of this document and return it to me via email. This will help me identify and track Hinds students who apply to Delta State.
- (2) Apply for admission to Delta State University at www.deltastate.edu (Application fee is \$25.00.)

Below please find a “Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)” sheet with information on admission requirements, tuition, scholarships, financial assistance, and course offerings.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. **How may I apply?** The application process has two steps:
 - a. Complete the “Applicant Information Sheet” found at the end of this document and email it to Amanda Dickerson (adickerson@deltastate.edu)
 - b. Apply for admission to Delta State University online at www.deltastate.edu (Application fee is \$25.00.)
2. **What are the admission requirements?**

A student who was eligible for admission to the freshman class at Delta State but chose to attend another institution may transfer at any time as long as the student has a “C” average or better and is eligible to return to that institution.

Any student who was not eligible for admission to the freshman class must attend an accredited institution of higher learning other than one of Mississippi’s eight state-supported universities and attain a “C” average (2.0 G.P.A. on a 4.0 scale) in the following 24 semester credit hours.

6 semester hours English Composition
3 semester hours College Algebra or above
6 semester hours Laboratory Science
9 semester hours Transferable Electives

3. **What are tuition costs?** For full-time students (12 – 19 hours), the cost is currently \$2,225 for in-state and \$3,366 for out-of-state fee. For part-time students, in-state tuition is \$185 per semester hour and \$466 per semester hour for out-of-state. These amounts are subject to change.

Details of the **Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship** are as follows: The award for Phi Theta Kappa is \$6,200.00 payable \$1,550.00 for four consecutive semesters. Once at Delta State, students must complete 30 semester hours with a 3.0 to continue eligibility for the last semesters.
