| 2. ACT scores. A minimum composite score of 18 is required. Sub-scores of 18 in the Reading and Math area are required. Information for taking the ACT may be obtained from all HCC Counseling Departments. <i>[If the ACT was taken prior to October 1989, required scores are minimum 16 Composite, 15 Math, and 16 Reading.]</i> | | | | | |
| 3. GPA of 2.5 on high school course work or at least 20 hours of transferable college credits with a GPA of 2.5. Official transcripts from all colleges attended (except Hinds) must be submitted. | | | | | |

Process for selection to the program: For classes that begin in the fall term, all selection criteria must be completed by March 31. For classes that begin in the spring term, all selection criteria must be completed by September 30. Individuals who have submitted all required admission criteria by the specified deadline will be considered for program admission based on a rating scale that includes ACT Composite Score, ACT Math and Reading sub-scores, and previous certificates or degrees. Applicants not selected for a class may reapply for subsequent classes by submitting a new Application for Selection to the Associate Degree Nursing Program.
