Students must take and pass the PRAXIS examination. Effective Fall 1996, the State Board of Education approved an exemption to the teaching exam for any student who had an ACT composite score of 21 (SAT equivalent of 860) with no sub-score below 18 UPON HIS/HER INITIAL ENROLLMENT INTO COLLEGE. A student who has earned any college credit before taking the ACT does not qualify for this exemption. Students applying for admission to the Teacher Education Program must have an overall (cumulative) grade point average of at least 2.5.
