2. An overall 2.6 GPA on ALL college level work and a 2.6 GPA on the 18 hour business core (* above) is required for admission to the Bachelor of Professional Accountancy program plus completion of two semesters of Accounting Principles with at least a "B" in each of the courses.
3. MSU requires an international elective. Geography (GEO 1113) or Comparative Government (PSC 2113) will satisfy this requirement; however, at Hinds these courses are usually taught on-line only. The second semester of a foreign language may also be used to satisfy the international elective. If not choosing any of these courses, take a college-level academic elective course and take the international elective at MSU.
