**Notes:**

- Drawing I is a prerequisite. **This course may be waived if the student earns an "A" or "B" in Drawing I.**
- The Architecture program at MSU is a five year program, and Hinds can provide only one true year of coursework for students pursuing the architecture major. **Students should consult an advisor at the School of Architecture at MSU (662-325-2202) during their freshman year in order to determine the point at which they should transfer.** Students who have not planned their courses carefully will likely find that their program will take six years to complete. **Be aware that not all the electives will transfer into the architecture program.** The program provides only 3 electives during the student's entire five-year program. Elective credit will only be given for college level academic courses

**Applicants must apply to Mississippi State by February 15 of the year they plan to enroll** to be eligible for the summer and fall terms. Transfer students must have at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA on the following courses: English Composition I and II, General Physics I and II, and Freehand Drawing I, and have at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA on all courses to be admitted to the program. **No grade below "C" will be accepted in ANY course in the student's curriculum.**
