NOTES:

- Any laboratory science course will satisfy this general requirement. **Students should consult a State catalog and a Hinds advisor for suggestions as to specific science courses listed in their major.** Principles of Biology does not transfer into science majors. The physical science course may be chosen from CHE, GLY, or PHY courses (Not physical science survey for science majors).
- Students who have completed two years of the same language in high school and have the proficiency may begin that same language at the intermediate level and satisfy this requirement. Other students should begin their language the first semester of enrollment in order to complete the 9- hour requirement. At the current time, Hinds does not teach French III and IV, so students choosing that language should begin their study during the sophomore year.
- Students who do not start their foreign language until their second year at Hinds should take two additional Social Science courses.
