**NOTES:**

To be admitted to the College of Education at MSU, the student MUST HAVE COMPLETED ALL REQUIREMENTS listed on this sheet with a minimum GPA of 2.75 on the core curriculum. Students must take and pass the Pre-Professional Skills Test (PPST) and obtain at least the following minimum scores: Reading - 170, Writing - 172, Mathematics - 169, or the Computer Based Test (CBT) with the following minimum scores: Reading - 316, Writing - 318, Mathematics - 314. Packets for taking these tests are available in the Academic Counseling Department on the Raymond Campus. These tests should be taken no later than spring of the sophomore year. *Effective Fall 1996, the State Board of Education approved an exemption to the PPST for any student who had an ACT composite score of 21 (SAT equivalent of 860) with no sub-score below 18 UPON HIS/HER INITIAL ENTRANCE INTO COLLEGE. A student who has earned any college credit before taking the ACT does not qualify for this exemption. Two letters of recommendation are required and verification of 40 hours work experience with children. These forms are available from HCC counselors.*

\*\*A minimum grade of "C" is required in each of these courses.
