- Should be chosen from the student's alternative major. Students majoring in an agriculture field should choose from Animal Science, Soils, and Plant Science. Students majoring in other areas should consult a listing of courses for those majors. Courses chosen from the Technical division of the college will not transfer.

An applicant must have a grade point average of 3.0 (B) or above in all required science and mathematics classes and a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 in all undergraduate courses at the time of application. No grade below "C" will transfer in any required course. Applications are accepted through October 1 each year for the upcoming academic year. The Graduate Record Examination (GRE) is required for admission consideration. No minimum score is required, however. Scores must be in the Office of Student Affairs by October 1 of the application year. Of the 3 required letters of recommendation, one must be from a veterinarian.
