- Electives to complete the 64 hours should be chosen with the help of a college advisor. The additional courses to complete the 64 hours of credit should be chosen from the student's individual major. Consult the MSU *Catalog* for a listing of required courses.

*Before being admitted to the Teacher Education Program, the student must take and pass the Pre-Professional Skills Test (PPST) and obtain at least the following minimum scores: Reading – 170, Writing – 172, Mathematics – 169, or the Computer Based Test (CBT) with the following minimum scores: Reading – 316, Writing – 318, Mathematics – 314. Students who have earned a composite score of at least 21 on the ACT with no sub-score below 18 or 860 on the SAT before their first enrollment into any college are exempt from the PPST/CBT test requirement. Registration Packets for these examinations are available in the Academic Counseling Department on the Raymond Campus.

*Students must have a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 to be admitted to the Teacher Education Program. A minimum grade of “C” must be earned in the English composition, speech, and mathematics courses. Two letters of recommendation are required and verification of 40 hours of work experience with children. These forms are available from HCC Counselors.
