Deadline for filing an application to the School of Pharmacy is February 1. Contact the School of Pharmacy at (205) 726-2982. The Pharmacy College Aptitude Test is an admission requirement. No on-line classes or AP credits are accepted for science courses, and CLEP credits are not accepted in any university core courses.
