Notes:

1. A higher math than college algebra will also satisfy this requirement. Some majors may require a first math higher than college algebra. Check the Ole MS *Catalog* for math requirements for specific majors.
2. Students who have taken two years of the same foreign language in high school and have the proficiency to begin college language at the intermediate level may choose to enroll at that level; however, they will also have to take a 300 level language course at Ole Miss to complete this requirement. Students who lack intermediate proficiency must take 12 hours of the same foreign language beginning at the entry level to complete this requirement. At the current time, Hinds does not teach French III and IV; thus, a student choosing French should begin language study in the sophomore year.
3. Elective courses must come from **college level Academic courses**. Technical and vocational courses WILL NOT TRANSFER to the university. If possible, students should choose elective courses from their chosen major. Bachelor of Arts degrees are awarded in the following areas:
