All applicants for admission must present an ACT enhanced score of 21 or above and an overall grade point average of at least 2.5.

The baccalaureate nursing program at UMC is a five semester program beginning in the summer. Applications become available July 1 for the following May class. Grade point average on required courses and personal and professional career goals and community service activities will also be used in the selection process. A personal interview and an on-site writing sample may be required. **UMCC admits one class per year. Applicants may apply for admission when the number of prerequisite courses completed, plus those on the plan of study, equals 63 semester hours. All prerequisite courses must be completed before beginning any UMC nursing course.

Applications are reviewed for the BSN program in the fall for Early Decision and in February for the annual summer admission. To be considered for Early Decision, applications must be complete by November 1, and applicants must have completed 30 hours in the prerequisite courses of which 14 hours must be in the prerequisite natural sciences and mathematics. Applications that are not accepted for Early Decision are placed in the applicant pool review of all applicants at the February review date. The deadline date for all applications to be complete and in the Office of Student Services and Records is January 15. A non-refundable application fee of \$25.00 must accompany each application.
