A year of high school chemistry or equal value college chemistry course is required prior to enrollment in General Chemistry. In addition, the student must be at placement level 3 (Intermediate Algebra) to take Principles of Chemistry and placement level 4 (College Algebra) to take General Chemistry.

Sixteen hours of observation in 2 different occupational therapy clinical setting are required before the January 15 deadline for applications. Applications may be submitted starting the prior July 1. This is now a masters degree program but is entered after the completion of the prerequisite courses.
