This is now a doctoral level program. To enter the program, applicants must have a baccalaureate degree from an accredited institution of higher learning. The GRE is a requirement. No specific major is required.

A minimum grade of "C" required in each course with an overall GPA of 3.0. UMC counts all hours attempted. Average GPA for admitted students is 3.75. Students should apply to the University Medical Center by the second Tuesday in November. Forty hours of observation in at least two different physical therapy settings are required during the current year of application. A maximum of 20 hours may be used from any one site. Applications and observations may be submitted as early as July 1, the year prior to enrollment. A counselor in the physical therapy department will answer specific questions about prerequisite requirements or career opportunities.
