All courses marked with the asterisk (*) must be completed with a grade of "C" or higher and a minimum 2.5 grade point average in order to make application for progression in the program. Students must also submit a portfolio of their work for review by the Interior Design faculty. Portfolios must be submitted at least one semester before the expected enrollment date.
