In addition to filing an application to the USM College of Nursing, the following minimum requirements must be met for consideration for admission to the College of Nursing: (1) An Enhanced ACT of 21 or above or comparable SAT score. (2) An overall grade point average of 2.5 on courses prerequisite to the nursing major. (3) A minimum of a "C" in each prerequisite course in the nursing curriculum. (4) Proof of current CPR certification. [**Note: Only one natural science course may be repeated one time.**] *Students having completed at least 75% of the prerequisite nursing courses may make application to the College of Nursing for progression to the Nursing major. Application forms may be obtained through the Office of Student Services, Room 116, Harkins Hall. The deadline for return of completed applications is **March 1 for fall admission and October 1 for spring admission.** Contact the School of Nursing at 601-266-5445 for additional information regarding this program.*
