In addition to filing an application to the USM College of Nursing, the following minimum requirements must be met for consideration for admission to the College of Nursing: (1) An Enhanced ACT of 21 or above or comparable SAT score. (2) An overall grade point average of 2.5 on courses prerequisite to the nursing major. (3) A minimum of a "C" in each prerequisite course in the nursing curriculum. (4) Proof of current CPR certification. [**Note: Only one natural science course may be repeated one time.**]
