- The student who has taken and passed two years of the same foreign language in high school may choose to start his college foreign language at the intermediate level and thus take only one full year of foreign language. **Foreign Language I courses should usually be started in the fall semester of the freshman year. *At the current time, French III and IV are not taught at Hinds. Students choosing French I should begin their studies during the sophomore year and take additional electives. With approval of SPT advisor, students may substitute 9 hours of sign language.**
