

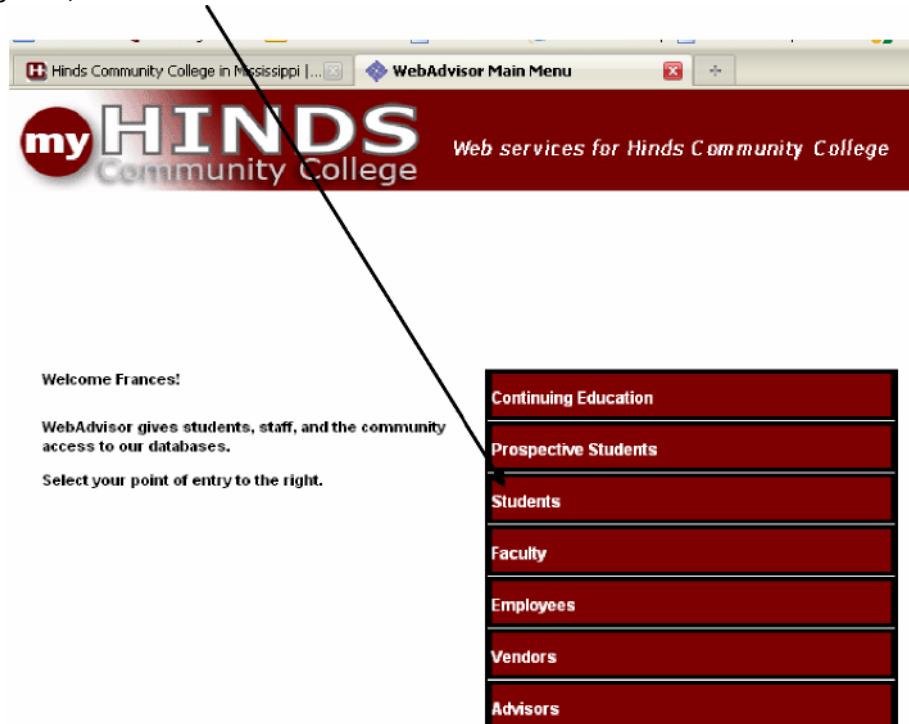
INSTRUCTIONS FOR SINGLE COURSE WITHDRAWAL USING MY.HINDS

*(THIS IS THE METHOD FOR WITHDRAWING FROM TRADITIONAL CLASSROOM COURSES.
WITHDRAWAL FROM MSVCC/ONLINE CLASSES IS INITIATED IN THE ADMISSIONS OFFICE.)*

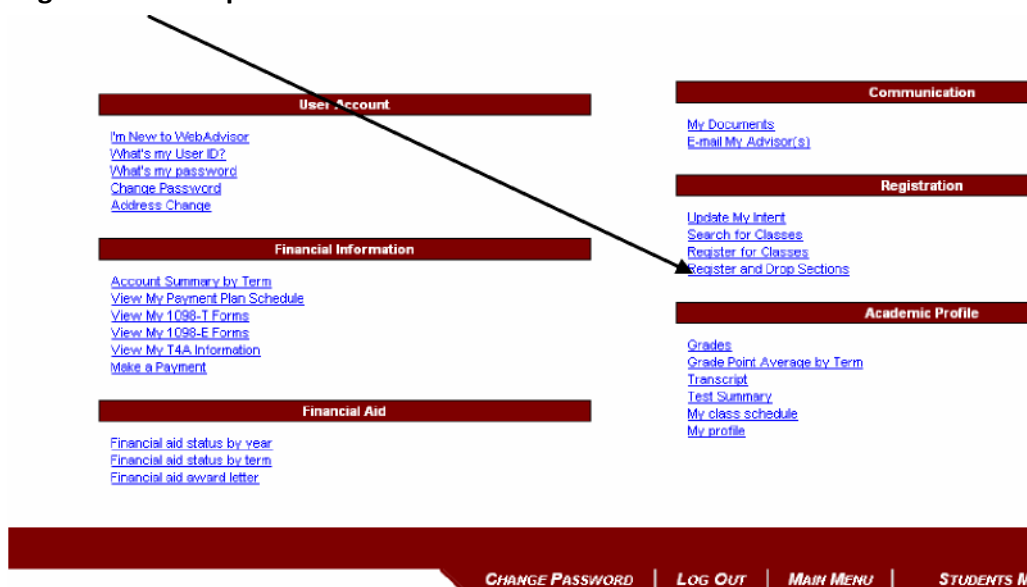
Log-in instructions for my.hinds can be found at www.hindscc.edu/online.

NOTE: The withdrawal process in My.Hinds will be open during the withdrawal window only. Students may not completely withdraw from the College through this process. COMPLETE WITHDRAWALS MUST BE INITIATED IN THE COUNSELING OFFICE.

1. Once logged in, click the **Students** menu bar.



2. Click **Register and Drop Sections**.



3. Carefully read the warning at the top of the screen.

 - You may be required to vacate your residence hall if the withdrawal drops you below fulltime status.
 - At the time you withdraw from this course, your fees will be recalculated and you may owe a balance or may be due a refund. In such cases, an invoice (bill) or refund will be mailed to you.
