

PRACTICAL NURSING PROGRAM OUTCOMES

REQUIRED OUTCOMES	DEFINITION	EXPECTED LEVEL OF ACHIEVEMENT
PROGRAM COMPLETION	The percentage of students who complete the nursing program within 150% of the time of the stated program length.	At least 60% of students entering the program will complete the program. (beginning fall 2009)
PERFORMANCE ON LICENSURE EXAM	The percentage of graduates who pass the NCLEX-PN® on the first write.	The program's three-year mean on NCLEX-PN® for all test takers is at or above the national test average.
JOB PLACEMENT	The percentage of graduates employed in nursing practice.	At least 90% of the graduates will indicate employment in nursing practice within 6 months after graduation.
PROGRAM SATISFACTION	The degree to which the employer and graduates express satisfaction with the overall preparation of graduates from the Practical Nursing Program.	At least 90% of the employers responding to the employer survey and 90% of the graduates responding to the graduate survey will rate the graduate's overall preparation to practice nursing as satisfactory.
