Program completion rate

Program completion rate is defined as the number of students who complete the clinical phase of the program within 150% of the stated program length. The program length of the clinical phase of the program is 12 months and program completion is defined as those students graduating within 18 months of beginning the clinical phase of the program. The last date for withdrawal, Fall Semester of the student's first year, is the beginning date set by this program for recording the number of students beginning the program.
