Music Major Scholarships

Full tuition scholarships are available for incoming freshmen who major in music. Students need to have an ACT composite score of 16 or higher to be considered. These students should make application and call the Music Department to schedule an audition. Since freshman music majors enroll in an average of 18 hours, it is important to be prepared for college work. Students enrolled in more than one development course will have an opportunity to audition for a scholarship upon completion of developmental courses with a 3.0 GPA. The music major scholarship is renewable for three semesters, provided that the semester GPA in music remains at 3.0 or above and the overall GPA is 2.5 or above.
