SCHOLARSHIP

The Mississippi Automotive Wholesalers Association, Inc. Scholarship was established to aid students at the community/junior college level that are majoring or planning to major in a Career-Technical automotive program. The first of these scholarships were awarded in the 2002-2003 Academic Year.

Each year, this scholarship is awarded to two students who meet the following eligibility criteria:

- a) must be a full time student at one of Mississippi's 15 public community or junior colleges in the area of automotive repair or maintenance, to include but not limited to auto body repair, auto mechanics, auto parts or auto machinist;
- b) must have a 2.5 or better high school and/or community or junior college grade point average
- c) must be free of any disciplinary problems;
- d) must show evidence of financial need; and
- e) must attend any scholarship recognition program developed by the college.

In order to be considered for this scholarship, the student must submit an application packet that includes:

- a completed application
- three letters of recommendation
- a list of achievements
- a high school and/or community or junior college transcript
- and a summary outlining why the student should be considered for the scholarship (to include any outstanding financial need)

The recipient of the scholarship will be selected by a scholarship committee, appointed by the Assistant Executive Director for Workforce and Economic Development at the Mississippi Community College Board. The recipient may retain the scholarship for a maximum of two academic years (four consecutive semesters), if he or she maintains full time status, a 2.5 or better grade point average, and continues to exhibit the qualities outlined above. The amount of the scholarship will be \$500.00 per year.
